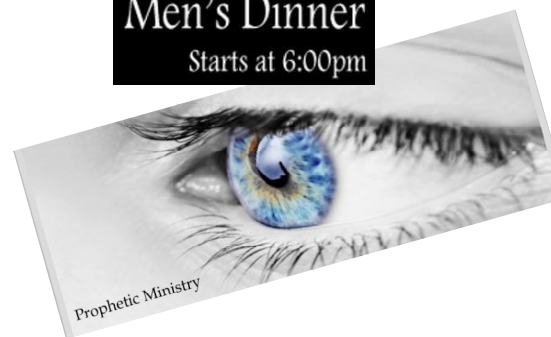

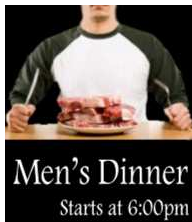

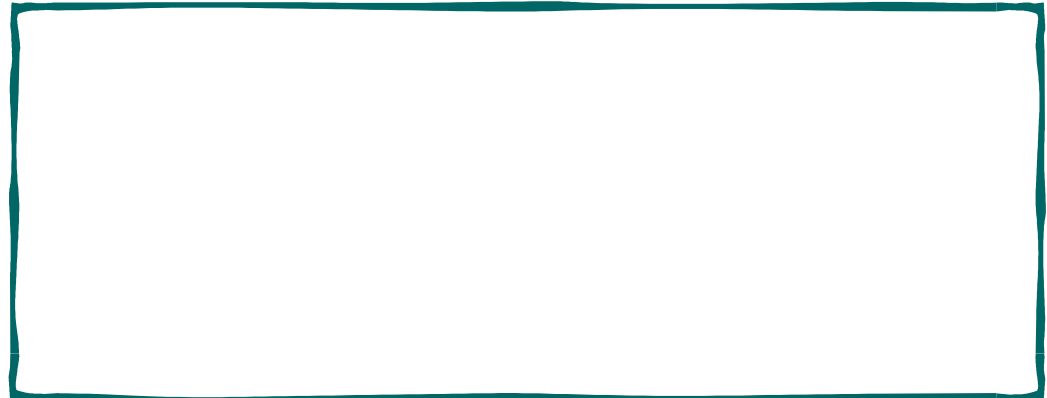

Prophetic team Culture

As team Leader of the Prophetic in St John's, I have a passion for the Prophetic and to see others also hear God's voice, to grow in the gifts and practice prophesy to help build up the Body of Christ.

St. Johns has created a culture that values the Voice of the Lord and we believe that all may prophesy. Although not all are prophets we are **ALL** called to prophesy and we are encouraged to stir up the gift of God which is in you...and to consider how we may spur one another on towards love and good deeds.to encourage one another.... 2 Timothy 1:6/Hebrews10:24.

St. Johns has created a safe place for all to hear from the Lord to encourage each other. New people are welcome to participate, but as you are new it is our practice to ask you to share your word first before sharing with the congregation.

Because we are all at different levels of spiritual growth and understanding, the prophetic team runs a monthly Equipping Station with the purpose to train and equip the Body of Christ to go deeper in their understanding of the gifts and also to step out and practice prophesy or the gifts.

St. Johns believes in empowering the Body of Christ to come to understand the gifts and gift God has given and to step out.... whether that be inside or outside of the Sunday service.

Every Sunday we wait on God to speak forth Words for the church, or we share testimonies, or ask someone to sit in the 'hot seat'. I find it is a good idea that during the week you prepare yourself by seeking God for words for someone so that you can participate.



We also have prophetic art for anyone who sees in pictures or colours and can translate artistically. We have paint, brushes and paper set up in a desk ready for this purpose.

For those who enjoy doodling there is a Prophetic doodling spot in the bulletin is for this.

Early in 2020 we possibly have John Fergusson coming. As the prophetic team leader it is not for me to come up with everything, but to help others lead as well. So if there is something burning on your heart then come and chat and we will see what we can make happen.
