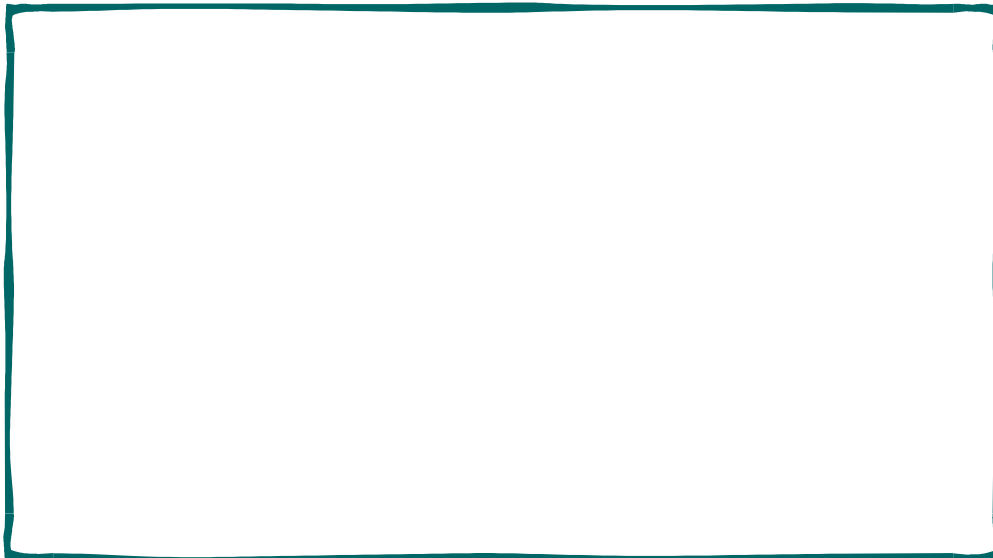

Trewavas Update and Request

Mark, Katrina and their family former Pastors from Hawera who are currently serving in a remote area overseas, send their greetings and blessings. They remain encouraged by the prophetic words that we have blessed them with when they last visited with us.

Mark is working on a new venture which has presented a great opportunity to reach a people group who have "Animist" beliefs which is where the spirit world has a constant influence on the natural world. They live in constant fear of these spirits and life for them is trying to keep these spirits happy. These people want to be set free from the bondage of trying to please them but need Christians to share the gospel and disciple them.

Mark has begun an Agro-forestry project which has been given permission by the Authorities to work in the area. They have formed a relationship with the national Agricultural Research Association to better improve farming techniques and aim to give farmers a hope for a better life. They will be borrowing 1 hectare from a family in a remote village for 3 years and making it a demonstration farm. In addition to this there will be monthly training days for the villagers.

This 3 year Project has 5 goals:

- To introduce more sustainable farming techniques
- To introduce new crop varieties
- To help the farmers make wise financial decisions
- To help the farmer market their products
- The most important goal of all is to plant churches in the area.

Mark's previous role before becoming a Pastor was a Farm Advisor in Taranaki so he is well equipped for this task.

Mark has employed a Christian man who is very experienced in agriculture to help with the project. He also has the dual role of being a Church planter. Mark is seeking support of \$1,000 for this year to supplement the worker's wages. He would be very grateful if you would prayerfully consider donating to this project.

All donations will be received by the Church Office and then forwarded to him.
