Senior Sergeant Drew Bennett and Michelle Ramage (Roderique Hope Trust) have conveyed their sincere thanks for the \$13,226.00 contributed in the offering for Operation Blue Santa. They were astounded by such generosity and were able to distribute 156 baskets to at risk families across Taranaki for Christmas.

Holding this event in the stadium was a big step of faith practically and financially as everything was hired in, set up and then packed down again. Our total expenses have come to just over \$19,000. We are so pleased to advise that, within the last few days and thanks to the generous donations of so many, these expenses are now covered.

Free BBQ lunch and drinks are being provided by Treasure Seekers at its annual Pool Day at the Aquatic Centre.



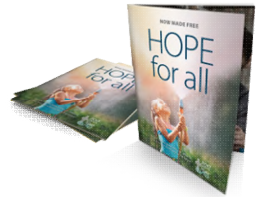
Pay your admission fee and join them after Church today for a fun filled afternoon.
