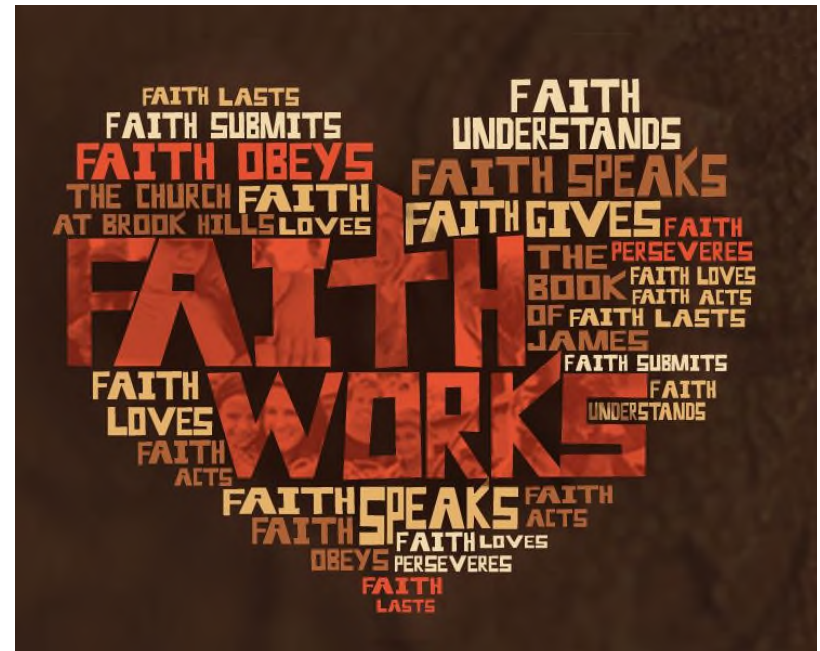

## **THE POWER OF PROPHETIC VISION**

**with Jeremy Witherow**

The difference between a Christian who does something great with their life and one who doesn't is whether their life is propelled by 'prophetic vision.' When we know God's unique purpose for our life, and when an image of His potential for us burns deep into our heart, then we'll live for something bigger than ourselves. If our lives are not governed by prophetic vision, our spiritual lives are at risk, as the writer of Proverbs highlights:

"Where there is no vision, the people are unrestrained" (Proverbs > 29:18).

Without vision, we'll more readily tolerate sin and compromise.

We'll trudge carefully along the path of least resistance, while doing everything we can to avoid discomfort. But if we allow an inspired vision for our life to captivate us, we'll be willing to go through the trials and setbacks to see our fullest potential

realised. We will also embrace life as the faith adventure it's intended to be. Sadly, many Christians struggle to articulate or to even know God's vision for their life. It's not uncommon to these days, "I don't have a vision for my life...I don't know what God has called me to do." Statements like these raise questions like: "How would I go about discerning God's will for my life and to receive a personal vision to inspire me?" In this session, Jeremy will help us better understand what a true prophetic vision entails and why it's so important to live according to one. He will also help us discover how we can go about receiving a personal vision for our own life. Topics covered, include:

- The Nature of Vision
- The Implications of a God-given Vision
- The Three Types of 'Sight'
- A Strategy for Receiving a Personal Vision
- Signposts that Affirm and Confirm Personal Vision
