Thank you for your cooperation and understanding as we navigate the ever changing situation of this pandemic.



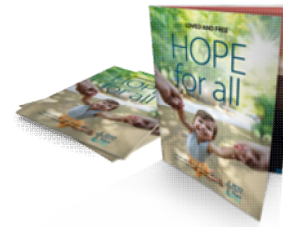
### Laugh your way to a better marriage course
