## Annual General Meeting Report for Thee King Trust

The Thee King Trust has continued to meet quarterly this last year, so my thanks to the other trustees; Neil Walker, Janice Bewick, Selwyn Tait and Suzanne Hokopaura.

It's with great thanks to God for His provision over this last year. With inflation and the struggle of Covid still affecting local businesses, having our new tenant for the Glover Road property, BuildTech has been a real blessing. We've been able to look at two long-awaited projects and give a Hungarian Church a donation for Ukraine. The two projects are the fence and roof at the Camberwell Road house (Kingsley House). While these planned repairs occur after this year's balance date, all are funded. The fence was completed in September, and the roof will commence in February 2023.

This year we have had a contract where we have provided Social Work services to the South Taranaki Kahui Ako school cluster. This has been a great success and the cluster has found it so beneficial that the contract has been extended through to January 2024.
