### Operation Christmas Child

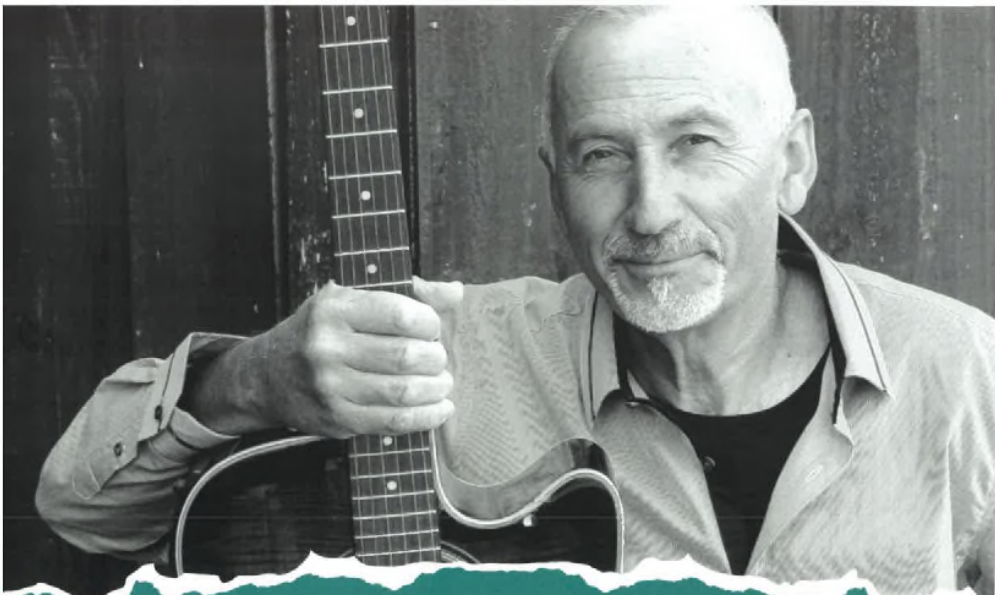
Boxes are now available to fill.
